Christina Lamm:

Every person has a story, and without knowing it and feeling compassionate about it, you're not going to be able to provide the best work product for them as you can.

Hey, my name is Christina Lamm. I'm an associate attorney at the firm. I've actually wanted to be an attorney since I was very young. I think one of the most important things about having a team approach is that we're able to, if something, if an answer doesn't come to us right away, we're able to bounce it off of Ellen or off of Deirdra and come back and get a better approach on something.

One of the things I noticed here is that Ellen and everyone else who works here really cares about each individual client and this particular area of law. I actually feel like I'm helping people and I'm doing some good. Especially in this line of work, you need to actually care about each individual person. You have to really get into their individual story. You have to listen to everything about the client and figure out which one would work best for them. Because it's not a one size fit all thing at all, and it's really important to me.
