College Students Need a Power of Attorney and Health Care Proxy Too!



Your teenager worked hard throughout high school to get good grades so that applications could be made to the colleges of his or her choice. Now that the application process and the agonizing over selecting which college to attend are over, your soon-to-be college student is ready to embark on the next big chapter of life; however, there is still work to be done. As an agent appointed under a Health Care Proxy, a parent can make medical decisions for the student if the student is unable to make medical decisions for him or herself.
